APPLICATION CHECK LIST

- ▶ A check or money order in the amount of \$150 for your space. Note: you must send two (2) checks if a double space is requested. One check may be returned if only one space is assigned.
- ▶ Include four (4) images of your work and one (1) image of your entire display, and your current resume.
- ▶ One self-addressed, stamped #10 envelope for the return of your acceptance and space assignment.
- ▶ One large (9 x 12 inch or larger) self-addressed, stamped envelope with sufficient postage. (See "envelopes, mailers and postage" section for requirements) for the return of your images and postcards.
- ▶ Your completed application form. Every question must be answered.

ARTIST PRESENCE

Artists must present their work personally both days and may not employ any agents in their place. It is mandatory that each exhibitor attend both show days. Exhibits must be set-up for the public by 9:30 am each day, and dismantled no earlier than 5 pm on Saturday and 4 pm on Sunday. Demonstration work-in-progress is encouraged.

PARKING

After unloading tent and physical materials, your vehicle must be immediately moved to the designated free parking area. Staff will be available to direct and assist with your materials. Parking is one block from the exhibit area.

PERMITS

Every exhibitor is responsible for his/her own resale permit from the California State Board of Equalization. Place your resale number in the space provided in this application or attach an authorized tax exemption letter.

SECURITY / LIABILITY

Exhibitors will be able to set up their tents Saturday morning beginning at 6:00 am. Displays may be left overnight, but artists are discouraged from doing so. The show will provide overnight security, but there is no fencing. Show management cannot accept responsibility or liability for loss or damage to the exhibitor's property at any time during the show. All participants are responsible for their own liability insurance. **Art & Wine Affaire** will require each entrant to complete a "hold harmless" agreement.

The show reserves the right to remove any exhibitor before or during the show if the exhibitor is:

- *showing work not reflecting the quality of the work juried*
- *selling work or reproductions in editions over 500*
- *selling work that is not his/her own*
- *moving his/her space without permission*
- *selling inappropriate items such as t-shirts or novelty items*

ENTRY FEES

\$150 booth fee for 10 x 10 ft. space. If a double space is requested, enclose two separate checks. If only one space can be provided one check will be returned. Once an exhibitor has been accepted and assigned a space, there will be absolutely no refunds. In case of emergency, the entry fee will be applied to next year's show. There will be no refunds because of weather. The show will take place both days, rain or shine. Checks returned for any reason will be subject to a \$20 handling fee and must be replaced by a cashier's check or money order. There will be no sharing of spaces.

SCREENING PROCESS

A jury will make selections based on quality and originality as shown in your slides in comparison with other applicants in your category.

TYPE OF WORK EXHIBITED

Artists may exhibit work in more than one medium provided it is representative of work submitted for jurying. Sale of photographic reproductions is not acceptable. The committee has agreed that artists may sell high quality reproductions, lithographs, giclees etc., provided they are labeled as such for the purchaser to see. However these must be in clearly numbered editions, and those editions may not exceed 500. Postcards of exhibiting artists' work which are printed, laser or equivalent reproductions, and are so labeled for the purchaser to see, are permitted provided they are a small portion of the exhibitor's total work shown. If there are questions, the artist has the responsibility to clear with the show committee two weeks in advance of the show.

IMAGE SUBMISSION

Applicants must submit four (4) images of their work and one (1) image of their whole exhibit. Photographic slides or good quality prints, JPEGs on CD, are also acceptable.

ENVELOPES, MAILERS, POSTAGE

Two self-addressed, stamped envelopes must be included with your application as follows:

- (1) One 9 x 12 or larger envelope with sufficient first class postage to return your images and your free full-color postcard mailers. Images sent without a return envelope cannot be returned.
- (2) One self-addressed, stamped #10, business-size envelope for mailing your acceptance and space assignment.

Indicate the number of postcards that you would like on the application form and enclose additional postage as follows:

- \$3.00 for 25 postcards, \$4.00 for 50 postcards,
- \$4.50 for 75 postcards and \$5.00 for 100 postcards

EXHIBIT SPACE & REQUIREMENTS

Artist arrival times, on Saturday morning, will be staggered to make it easier for artists. Members of the show staff will be available to assist in the unloading and loading. Artists who leave early will not be invited to return to subsequent shows. Each exhibitor will have a 10' x 10' space (unless assigned and paid for a double space). All equipment and materials needed will be the responsibility of the artist. There will be no electrical hookups available. In general no umbrellas will be allowed. Exceptions must be approved by the show committee at the space site during set-up. Booth space not claimed by 8:00 am Saturday will be forfeited and reassigned.

2007 APPLICATION

All applications must be postmarked by January 31, 2007. Early applications are strongly urged. Location preference will be given to earliest entries. No refunds will be issued and no transfers will be allowed. Booths may not be shared. Please print or type all information.
